

Rules for Dressage High Score Awards

- The show season runs until November 30.
- For scores to count towards ECSJ year-end awards, riders must be ECSJ members at the time of the showing. Only ECSJ sanctioned shows will count toward ECSJ year-end awards
- To qualify for a year end high score award, horse-rider combinations must submit at least three scores from three different judges from three different show dates. One score must be the highest score from the highest test of the level and must be a minimum of 58%. The Average of these three scores will be used to rank the horse-rider combinations at each level.
- FEI riders who only need 2 scores from 2 different judges at 2 different shows. Both scores must be above 58%. The average of the scores will be considered.
- A 55% minimum average score is needed to qualify for any one high score award.
- Each horse/rider combination may qualify for high score awards at 2 consecutive levels only.
- Horse/rider combinations that have won a year-end championship at Starter thru Fourth Levels cannot compete for a high score award again at that level.
- F.E.I., levels horse/rider combination cannot win the same test more than two consecutive years
- Achievement ribbons will be awarded to Horse-Rider combinations receiving a score of 62% or higher on at least one test at any level if they have not won a year-end award.
- Scores MUST be submitted to Cara Tozour by December 15th .
- All results are final 10 days after posting.
- All scores and/or questions are to be addressed to the Year-End Awards Chairperson.
