

Dressage Medals

Dressage Medals are designed to recognize an achievement of consistent 60% scoring . They need not be earned in one year and are cumulative from March 2004. You must be a current member of ECSJ at the time the scores are earned. Scores may be earned at all ECSJ sanctioned shows. Riders may submit scores from different horses. You must send the dressage medal scoring sheet and copies of all tests to the awards coordinator by December 14th of year medal requirements are completed. Scores can be from the highest required level. Example 6 scores from first level submitted two scores must be from First Four vs. three from training and three from first level.

- ***The Bronze Medal*** : awarded to a rider who has achieved 3 scores of 60% or above at Training Level and three of 60% or above at First Level. At least 1 of the score must be at Training Level Test 4 and at least 1 must be at First Four. They must be from 4 different judges at 4 different shows.
- ***The Silver Medal*** : awarded to a rider who has achieved 3 scores of 60% or above at Second Level and 3 scores from Third Level. At least 1 score from Second Level Test 4 and 1 score from Third Level test four. These must be from a minimum of 4 different judges at 4 different shows.
- ***The Gold Medal*** : awarded to a rider who has achieved 4 scores of 60% or above Fourth Level and 2 FEI test of choice scores . At least 1 score from Fourth Level Test 3.. These must be from a minimum of 3 different judges at 3 different shows.
